Flat Rock Middle has been named as a 2023 Distinguished Title I School by the Georgia Dept. of Education, an honor given to the top 5 percent in the state

FLAT ROCK NAMED 2023 DISTINGUISHED SCHOOL

Flat Rock Middle School has been identified as a 2023 Title I Georgia Distinguished School by the Georgia Department of Education. This means that Flat Rock ranked in the top 5% with the highest absolute performance for the “all student” group based on combined ELA and Math content mastery scores for the 2022-2023 school year. This award qualifies the school as eligible for the 2023 National Distinguished School award. Congratulations to our Title I team, dedicated teachers, staff and students who made this recognition possible. 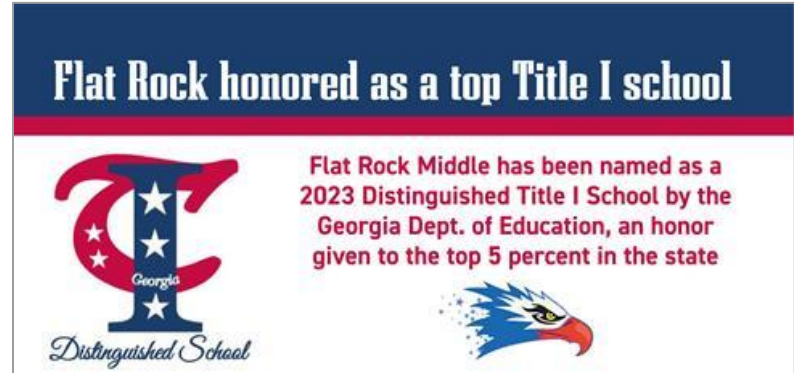
