One of Flat Rock's very own scholars Anderson Fernandez-Gomez (6C) fell ill during the holiday break with the Flu. His high fevers led to Anderson having several severe seizures and caused him to go into a coma for eight days. He has been diagnosed with Encephalomyelitis and lost all speech, function and mobility. Currently he is at Children's Hospital of Atlanta Rehab facility. His recovery will be extensive, and he may not return to FRMS this school year, however he has a great working spirit to come back strong. Anderson is a long time Jenkins Road family member, completing P-5th grade at Burch Elementary and currently enrolled at Flat Rock Middle School.

As our priority service project, FRMS's Divine Nine is leading an initiative to help support family funding by showing our committment to the #AndersonStrong donation campaign. Students and staff are encouraged to join us in support, by participating in \$5 Jean days on Tuesday February 13th, Thursday February 15th, and Thursday February 29th or a monatory dontation of any amount. All funds raised *February* through February will be presented to the family on March 1st.

Su recuperación será extensa y es posible que no regrese a FRMS este año escolar, sin embargo, el tiene un gran espíritu de trabajo para regresar fuerte. Anderson es miembro de la familia de Jenkins Road desde hace mucho tiempo y completó los grados Pk-5 en la Escuela Burch Elementary y actualmente esta matriculado en Flat Rock Middle School.
