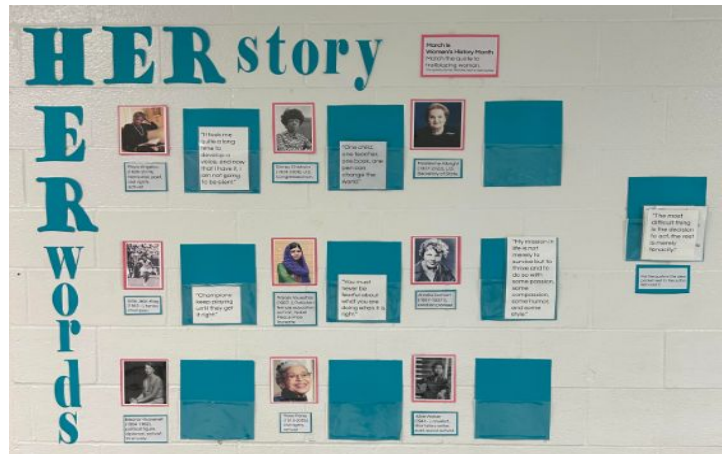
ANDERSON STRONG CAMPAIGN

STUDENT OF THE WEEK - HENRY PHAM

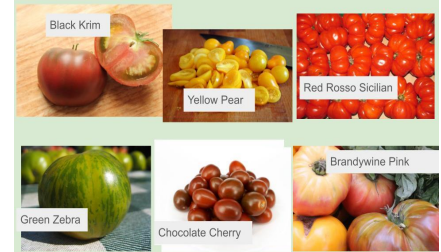
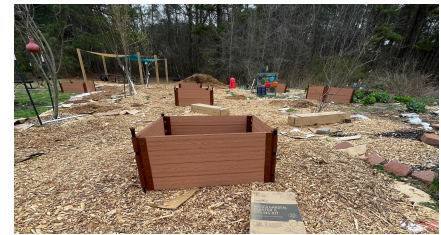

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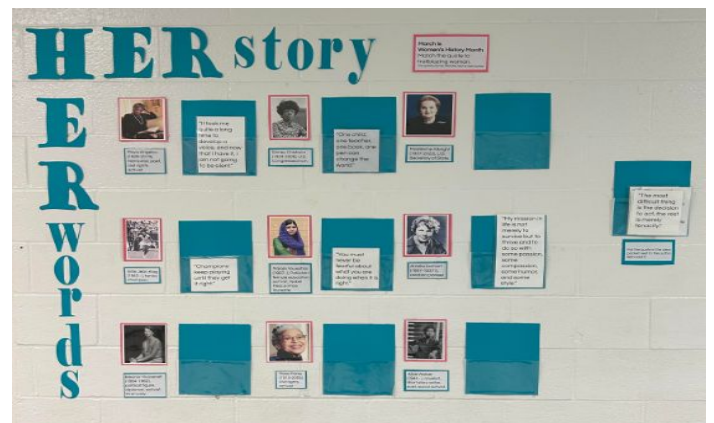
CAMPAÑA ANDERSON STRONG

EN LA GRANJA DE ALIMENTOS CON LA SRA. T

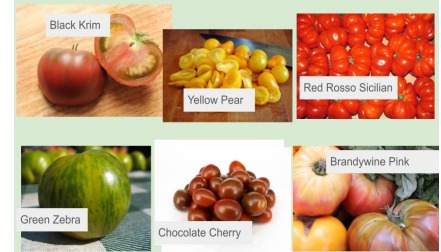
