PARENTS: Each family will receive ONE parking permit which will allow you to park ONE vehicle in the McIntosh High School parking lot during the Graduation ceremony. If you have handicap needs, the regular parking permit, which will be handed out to your senior, can be traded in for a handicapped parking permit. The handicapped parking permit will allow you to park your vehicle in the handicapped parking area. We are very limited on the number of spaces we have for parking. We must plan ahead for the correct number of handicapped parking as well as regular parking. The number on your parking permit is for school use only.
